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The **vulvar component** consists of **abnormal anatomy, investigative procedures, non-neoplastic epithelial disorders** (lichen sclerosus, squamous cell hyperplasia) and **other dermatoses and abnormalities** such as **inflammatory dermatoses** (contact or primary irritant, allergic, intertrigo, plasma cell vulvitis, lichen simplex chronicus, etc.); **chronic dermatoses** (seborrheic dermatitis, psoriasis, erosive and classic lichen planus, hidradinitis, fungal, atopic dermatitis, etc.); **ulcerative dermatoses** (herpes simplex 2, primary syphilis, chancroid, amebiasis, discoid lupus, lymphogranuloma venereum, Donovanosis, Behçet's syndrome, aphthosis, Crohn's disease, factitial vulvitis, familial benign chronic pemphigus, bullous pemphigoid, pemphigus vulgaris, erythema multiforme, herpes zoster, etc.); **cystic lesions** (mucous cysts, Bartholin's cyst and abscess, Skene's duct cyst, epidermoid inclusion cysts, furunculosis, etc.); **anatomic lesions** (hemangiomas, bruising, varicosities, lymphangioma circumscriptum, hernia, etc.); **solid lesions** (seborrheic keratosis, acrochordon, papillomatosis, lipoma, hidradenoma, angiomas, angiokeratoma, granuloma, syringomas, condyloma acuminatum, molluscum contagiosum, granular cell myoblastoma, sarcoid, condyloma lata (secondary syphilis), etc.); **pigmentary changes** (benign vulvar melanosis, melanocytic nevus, vitiligo, inflammatory hypo/hyperpigmentation, etc.); **mixed non-neoplastic/neoplastic epithelial disorders** (lichen sclerosus and intraepithelial neoplasia/cancer); **non-squamous intraepithelial neoplasia** (Paget's disease, melanoma in situ); **other histologies** (basal cell carcinoma, sarcoma, verrucous carcinoma, malignant melanoma, urethral squamous cell cancer, invasive Paget's, post-radiation skin changes, granulation tissue). The **vaginal component** consists of an **investigative approach, normal anatomy, non-neoplastic epithelial disorders** (squamous cell hyperplasia, adenosis, etc.); **inflammatory conditions** (atrophy, Candida, trichomonas, foreign body, erosions, allergic reaction, pyogenic granuloma, etc.); **non-inflammatory** (bacterial vaginosis, post-radiation, hemangiomas, granulation tissue, entrapped fallopian tube, etc.); **viral infections** (condyloma acuminatum, herpes simplex 2, cytomegalic virus); **benign cystic lesions** (mesonephric duct cysts, endometrioma); **neoplastic epithelial disorders** (intraepithelial neoplasia, squamous cell cancers); **other lesions** (melanoma, rhabdomyosarcoma, etc.).
